Work Party: Each pool membership is requested to come and participate in opening the pool for the new swim season. Participation in the work party can be done in one of a three ways:

Option 1: Come, sign-in, and perform a job/task from a list of projects (see list)

Option 2: Come early, sign-in, and bring some of the materials that are needed for the work party (see list)

Option 3: stay at home and pay the \$20 work party "assessment"

We hope that everyone who can attends the work day to do a job, or drop off materials. It's a great way to get to know the other members.

Pool Parties: Available M-Th from 7-10pm. Free for groups smaller than 25 with refundable deposit. In an effort to make parties safer, there are some additional party rules taking affect this year: Max site capacity is 62 persons. A party must have a 1:12 lifeguard to party attendee ratio or better. Proof of lifeguard procurement required one week prior to party. Contact Heidi to schedule.

Work Party Jobs: This is a partial listing of jobs that need to be done at the work party:

- Set up umbrellas and chairs
- Sweep out bathrooms and storage room
- Grease door hinges
- Clean glass/mirrors in bathroom and display case
- Clean off BBQ and throw ashes away
- Throw away broken patio chairs
- Power wash tables, chairs, BBQ
- Blow off all surfaces
- Clean bathroom and showers
- And more...

BBQ and Lounge Materials: Remember these rules:

- Inner-tubes and air matrices are banned.
- BBQs, if you bring your own, set it up in the same BBQ area.
- Gate Propping is a prohibited. Don't prop the gate open.

Work Party Materials: In order to perform some of the jobs during the work party, we are asking members to lend tools from 8am to 12noon that day. The member would be required to drop-off and pick-up their tools. This is the list of needed tools:

- Power washer
- Electric or gas leaf blower with extension cord if electric
- BBQ wire cleaning brushes
- Donate: Bathroom cleaning materials (soap, sponge, windex, paper towels, toilet wand, etc).

Pool Temperate: By popular demand, the pool temperature will be raised to 83 degrees. Hooray!
