Pool Parties: Available M-Th from 7-10pm. Free for groups smaller than 25 with refundable deposit. Max site capacity is 62 persons. A party must have a 1:12 lifeguard to party attendee ratio or better. Proof of lifeguard procurement required one week prior to party. Contact Heidi to schedule.

<u>Maintenance</u>: The water company required us to add a back flow prevention valve for the pool's water line.

This was a required upgrade.

Work Party Jobs: This is a partial listing of jobs that need to be done at the work party:

- Set up umbrellas and chairs
- Sweep out bathrooms and storage room
- Grease door hinges
- Clean glass/mirrors in bathroom and display case
- Clean off BBQ and throw ashes away
- Throw away broken patio chairs
- Power wash tables, chairs, BBQ
- Blow off all surfaces
- Clean bathroom and showers
- And more...

BBQ and Lounge Materials: Re-

member these rules:

- <u>Inner-tubes</u> and <u>air mattresses</u> are banned.
- <u>BBQs</u>, if you bring your own, set it up in the BBQ area.
- <u>Gate Propping</u> is a prohibited. Don't prop the gate open.

Work Party Materials: In order to perform some of the jobs during the work party, we are asking members to lend tools on the day of the work party. This is the list of needed tools:

- Power washer
- Electric or gas leaf blower with extension cord if electric
- Drill with bits
- Paint brush
- Dust pan
