Work Party Jobs: This is a partial listing of jobs that need to be done at the work party:

- Set up umbrellas and chairs
- Sweep bathrooms and closets
- Clean BBQ and ashes
- Throw away broken patio chairs
- Power wash tables, chairs, BBQ
- Blow off all surfaces
- Clean bathroom and showers
- And more...

Work Party Materials: In order to perform some of the jobs during the work party, we are asking members to lend tools on the day of the work party. This is the list of needed tools:

- Power washer
- Gas blower or electric with cord
- Paint brush
- Dust pan
- Donate: Cleaning materials: sponges, Clorox wipes, toilet wand

Pool Temperate: Back by popular demand, the pool temperature will be kept to 83 degrees, instead of the historic 80. Last summer we tested 85 and received feedback that it was too warm. This summer we will randomly test 84 and see how it goes. Finding a temperature that suits everyone is tough to do.

Polar Bear Swim Results: Participation in our new-year's polar bear swim increased by 50% this year (three people jumped instead of two). It was rainy, cold and lots of fun.
